Revolade (eltrombopag) will be eligible for reimbursement only if the patient satisfies the conditions listed below AND if the patient does not qualify for coverage under any other drug plan or government mandated program. If the patient is covered under another drug plan or government mandated program, the prior authorization program, as part of your drug benefits, may cover the portion not paid for by the primary plan. If “None of the above criteria” is indicated, the patient will not be eligible for reimbursement. **For Quebec plan members, please refer to the RAMQ exception drug criteria, if applicable.**

Eligibility Criteria

Please indicate if the patient satisfies the following criteria:

Treatment is being initiated and maintained by a physician who is experienced in the treatment of haematological diseases, who understands the benefits and risks associated with the treatment of ITP, and who is experienced in counselling patients for whom REVOLADE is indicated.

For Patients ≥ 18 years of age (approval period of 1 year):

For adult chronic immune (idiopathic) thrombocytopenic purpura (ITP) (13172003) to increase platelet counts in splenectomized patients who are refractory to first-line treatments (e.g. corticosteroids, immunoglobulins) or for adult non-splenectomized patients where surgery is contraindicated who are refractory to first-line treatments (e.g. corticosteroids, immunoglobulins). After 1 year of continuous treatment, therapeutic options should be reassessed; OR

To increase platelet counts in thrombocytopenic patients with chronic hepatitis C virus (HCV) infection (T990000045) to allow the initiation and maintenance of interferon-based therapy; OR

For the treatment of adult patients with severe aplastic anemia (SAA) (T990000046) who have had an insufficient response to immunosuppressive therapy.

For Patients ≥ 1 years and < 18 years of age (approval period of 1 year):

For pediatric chronic immune (idiopathic) thrombocytopenia (ITP) (13172003) to increase platelet counts in splenectomized patients who are refractory to first-line treatments (e.g. corticosteroids, immunoglobulins) or for pediatric non-splenectomized patients where surgery is contraindicated or not a suitable option and who are refractory to first-line treatments (e.g. corticosteroids, immunoglobulins). After 1 year of continuous treatment, therapeutic options should be reassessed; AND

Patient is able to swallow tablets whole.

Renewal Criteria (approval period of 1 year):

Demonstrated continued efficacy based on elevated platelet counts; AND

Platelet counts are less than 300x10⁹/L.

OR

None of the above criteria applies.
