New enhancements have been included in the Update Features for this software release. Some of these enhancements are:

Assyst-Rx-A Enhancements

Version Synchronization - Our version numbers have taken a jump in sequence. This realignment of version numbers for both Rx-A and POS are due to the major field expansions and for easier identification when both modules are in use.

Assyst Rx-A Enhancements

Compound Report

We have a new compound report. This report will include the patient name, Rx #, fill date and type of compound, basic billing information, lot number, expiry date, made by, verified by, compound ingredients, and compound notes. This report can be printed from the label window in either prescription process or patient profile and can be printed for any drug that is configured as a compound drug.

Drug Maintenance

A new compound type has been added to Drug Notes and can be used for any notes, including preparation instructions.

Field Expansions

Select fields within the application have been expanded for better performance. These are:

Compounds

Will now allow 3 decimal places on compound ingredients.

Drug Maintenance

The On Hand field has had the decimal places expanded to 3.

Fixed Fee Tables

The fixed fee table number has now been expanded from 9 to 99. This will allow for more fixed fees to be added to the application. The fixed fee table in Billing Calculations reflects this change, as well.

Markup Tables

The number of levels per table have been expanded from 9 to 99. An auto fill feature has also been added, Right clicking on either the +/- or %/\$ columns will give the option to autofill the remaining fields.

MethaMeasure

The duration field was expanded from 2 to 4 to match prescription process.

Pharmaspace

Pharmaspace will now handle the same expanded fields as Prescription Process.

Prescription Process

Authorized, remaining and fill quantity will handle more digits and will allow 3 decimal places for each. The combination before/after the decimal has a limit of 8 including the decimal (Ex: 12345.123).

Repeats have been expanded from 2 digits to 3, but the repeats will be sent to any third party as 99. (as refills are still only two digits at third parties).

Nursing Home window – The next fill quantity has been expanded to match the new field size of the fill quantity.

Any reports that report on these fields have been changed to reflect the field expansions.

Patient Profile

In both the Report and Grid view, a new TX option has been added.

In the Profile Grid view, Tx is now an option that can be added to display in the patients profile.

In the Patient Profile report, a new checkbox has been added for the Tx number to print.

Third Party Lookup

Two fields have been added to the Third Party Lookup window. They are: the AR account number and the integration code (kroll key, messaging key, ubik code). These fields can be used to sort in the grid or export to excel and print. This will make the integration setup easier.

Assyst Rx-A Changes

Attachments

A 'Not Authorized to View Attachments' error will no longer display when system authorization level is set on the attachments field authorizations.

A new purge routine has been added.

Drug Quick Maintenance

The export in Drug Quick Maintenance has been changed to properly reflect negative values for the autofill and on hand quantities. When the Field#2 value is set to on hands, the values will display correctly.

Label Maintenance

New codes for 'Age' (PG) and 'Gender' (PS) have been added.

Nursing Home Maintenance

A new option has been added to print pharmacist initials or name for SynMed only.

Packaging

For the SynMed packaging device, the Rx Price now gets sent to the machine.

Patient Lookup

Patients with two last names (separated by a space) will now display faster when searching.

Patient Maintenance

The Family Doctor field will now utilize the lookup function when pressing the enter key after a partial name has been entered.

Adding allergies (without FDB or Vigilance configured) to a patient will now save correctly.

Pill Pak

When adding multiple cards (and adding prescriptions to these cards) a prompt has been added to save whenever adding another new card and when clicking ESC on the add Rx function.

Pill Pak Report has had the stores postal code added.

Quick Launch

Prescription Process (if opened with the quick launch feature) will now have a delay so that Vigilance can update without any interference.

Prescription Process

The Substitute Drug button  has had a shortcut added (Alt S).

Both the Age and Birthdate will now display in Prescription Process.

We automatically deactivate the previous fill on Narcotic Repeat (F5), we will now do the same for Repeat New Number (F6). Deactivating means that the previous narcotic prescription will no longer display when the "Active Only (F3)" button is selected from the local patient profile.

With the Recalc flag set to Y, the remaining will calculate correctly when the duration and quantity are changed on a prescription.

Purchase Order Maintenance

When changing the sequence of items in the purchase order, duplicate items will no longer be displayed.

Receiving

Receive and order dates (during a receiving session) can no longer be saved as all zeroes.

Reminders

The initials field is now active even when Authorizations has not been turned on. This allows reminders to be resolved the same day when initials have been set.

Reports

Patient Drug Extract – The ability to exclude defers has been added to this report. If defers are included in the report, we have added an indicator (Stopped-Defer-Def/Stp) to show which prescriptions have a deferred status.

Plain Paper Mar – Long SIG codes will no longer be truncated. The three lines have expanded from 28 characters per line to 30 characters.

Compound Ingredient Report – The format of the phone number is now correct.

System Setup

A new tab has been added to System Setup. This tab is called Field Options. On this tab is a control section that allows the control of the starting field in drug maintenance (Cost 1, Name, DIN, Pack Size, on Hands and Form) and also which tab displays first (Flags, Ordering or Additional).

Third Party Maintenance

With integration turned on for Messaging, an error will no longer display when adding an initial third party code.
